The Marina charge explained

The Marina charge is the second element of the Rent Charge Deeds associated with the properties within Sovereign Harbour – the first element being the SW charge.

The Marina Charge recovers certain expenditure incurred by the Marina company in maintaining the sea defences for Sovereign Harbour.

Whilst the SW charge increases annually by reference to RPI, the Marina Charge is calculated directly by refence to prior year expenditure not met by the Marina company's share of the SW charge.



The Marina Charge

What does it cover:

- Primarily sea defences: Locks, dredging, bridges and water cleaning
- Work is carried out under a preventative maintenance programme


What it does not cover:

- Berth holder services:
- Pontoons, ablutions, boatyard, car parking, lighting



Summary of Marina Charge costs


Primary costs are dredging and maintaining the locks:
